

Kindergarten Halloween Information

This year we will celebrate Halloween at school on Tuesday, October 31st. Students ARE allowed to wear their costumes to school. Please see below for specific Halloween guidelines. In the morning, kindergarten will have a Halloween party at 10:00 with themed centers. Those who volunteered on the sign-up genius will attend. In the afternoon around 1:45, the children will parade around the haunted car yard around campus and "trunk or treat". We will then enjoy a sweet treat in the classroom after attending the haunted car yard. It will certainly be a SPOOK-tacular day!



Please keep the following kindergarten costume rules in in mind:

- Costumes must be comfortable and "bathroom friendly." Your student must be able to use the bathroom on his/her own. If the costume is complicated, consider wearing an alternative costume to school and saving the other for home.
- Leave all props at home: wands, gloves, brooms, whistles, plastic swords, light sabers, etc.
- Students will wear their regular (daily) masks with their costumes. Facial make-up is not allowed.
- Students must wear gym shoes.*
- Costumes must be school appropriate--NO violent or gory costumes, such as Freddy, Jason, etc. However, skeletons, witches, dracula, etc. are fine.
- NO clown costumes are allowed.
- We will NOT pass out Halloween candy in our classroom. Please do not send ANYTHING to school with your child to pass out. We already have a very busy day planned and I know the kids will have plenty of treats throughout the day! Thank you!
