

KINDERGARTEN HALLOWEEN INFORMATION



Dear families,

We will be celebrating Halloween at school on Friday, October 31st. Students ARE allowed to wear their costumes to school. Please see below for specific Halloween guidelines. In the morning, kindergarten will have a Halloween party at 10:15 with themed centers. Those who volunteered on the sign-up genius will attend and help us out, thank you! Volunteers should arrive around 10am. In the afternoon around 1:45, the children will parade around the block through the haunted car yard and "trunk or treat". You're more than welcome to participate by decorating your car and distributing candy to students. Families are welcome to begin decorating their cars at 12:45. Kindergarten students will make a trick or treat bag at their morning Halloween party to collect candy in, so no need to send anything in! It will certainly be a SPOOK-tacular day! Please keep the following kindergarten costume rules in mind:

Costumes must be comfortable and "bathroom friendly." Your student must be able to use the bathroom on his/her own. If the costume is complicated, consider wearing an alternative costume to school and saving the other for home.

Leave all props at home: wands, gloves, brooms, whistles, plastic swords, light sabers, etc.

Facial make-up is not allowed.

Students must wear gym shoes.

Costumes must be school appropriate--NO violent or gory costumes, such as Freddy, Jason; however, skeletons, witches, dracula, etc., are fine.

NO clown costumes are allowed.

Please do NOT send your child with candy or any kind of goodies to pass out. We are so, SO busy on Halloween. The day FLIES by with the party, trunk or treating and helping students get through the day in their costumes! It really helps us if we have less things to pass out. We know they'll still be getting plenty of goodies!
